

## 90 Red Mill Rd. Lebanon Twp, NJ



### Open House Sunday June 12 from 1:00 to 4:00

The original stone part of this historic home was William Crater's blacksmith shop back in 1847. One of the oldest buildings in Lebanon Twp, it is featured in the Lebanon Twp 200 Years book published by the Historical Society. The original sliding barn door has been preserved and can be seen on the north side of the house.

The sunny kitchen has Zodiaq quartz counters, better than granite, as they never need sealing and don't stain. The window over the farmhouse sink looks out over the trout stocked creek to 43 acres of preserved land behind the house. French doors off the kitchen lead to the deck where you might enjoy dinner and a sunset. The old blacksmith shop is a great place for your home office, as you can open the window to hear the song of the Spruce Run creek as you work.

The Jotul wood stove keeps the kitchen and dining area warm and cozy in winter. Beautiful honey colored wood floors throughout shine in the sunlight.

The laundry is conveniently located upstairs, near the two large bedrooms. The main bedroom has a large walk-in closet, and lots of light, while the second bedroom is spacious enough for have a separate sitting area if you like. The beautifully restored bath features a claw foot tub. The deck was rebuilt in 2014, new kitchen appliances and countertops were installed in 2007, and the furnace was replaced in 2013.

A lovely, quiet, and peaceful hideaway, surrounded by more than 140 acres of preserved land, yet only 6 miles to the High Bridge train station, and 8 miles to the NY bus to Port Authority.
