Commanding a stately presence on the privileged location of Main Street, Middletown, Gray Haven impresses passersby with its sprawling lawn, beautifully landscaped front courtyard, and three-story gabled roof line. While not on the register of historic homes itself, Gray Haven is one of twelve homes in Middletown's Historic Airview District and was the first ornate concrete block home built in Frederick. Professionally remodeled and decorated, Gray Haven encapsulates a rich history alongside every modern luxury and upgrade desired!

Rich chestnut front doors topped with a decorative transom provide a smart contrast to the cool grey home front and swing open into the wide foyer for a grand entry. Natural light pours in from vast windows, sunbathing the gleaming heart pine floors and light-colored walls throughout the interior. Gather in the family room at the end of the day to enjoy each other's company and the crackle of a wood fire set in the original brick fireplace. In the formal living room, golden trim lifts the eye to the eleven foot ceiling with an ornate center medallion and chandelier. Host cocktail hour in front of the statement fireplace with original Italian glazed tile, embossed bronze screen, beveled glass mirrors, and walnut mantle and over mantle. With a matching fireplace in the dining room, parties will seamlessly transition to around the table with family and friends sharing lively conversation over gourmet meals prepared in the adjoining chef's kitchen.

Custom designed with sophisticated taste, the generous kitchen features a glinting granite center island with breakfast bar, prep sink, and built-in cabinetry for optimal functionality. Sautee over the six burner gas stove with range hood, tile backsplash, and pot-filler, or wash up at the large second sink with a sleek granite backsplash. A contrasting custom breakfront pantry embroiders the layout while in-cabinet outlets allow for convenient concealment of small appliances. Appointed with two dishwashers, stainless steel appliances, a walk-in second pantry, and a dining room pass through, nightly meals will become a cherished ritual in this dream kitchen.

The first upper level offers generous sleeping quarters and a stunning master suite. One bedroom boasts an en suite bath while the others share a hall bath with dual vanity and a glass enclosed shower-tub combination. Retreat into the master suite through double doors to a wide bedroom with windows overlooking the rear lawn. Through French doors, the master bath offers separate custom cherry raised vanities, a marble-tiled shower, a clawfoot soaking tub, and two closets. The walk-in dressing room closet provides pull-out shelving, hanging racks, and jewelry drawers making for effortless morning routines. A bedroom-level laundry room concludes the first upper story.

Ascend to the second upper level to find an additional family room with charming dormer window seats and ample storage space. An additional, generous bedroom with an open closet has an adjacent full bath with an antique claw-foot tub. Additional rooms offer office, gym, or hobby space on the third story.

In the rear lawn, a natural stone patio, water-feature, and lush landscaping invite outdoor living and lead to each of the two outbuildings. The original carriage or smokehouse offers secure garden storage, an attached fenced cutting garden , and a climate controlled greenhouse. The original bank barn now

functions as a garage on the main level. From the circular drive to the lighted half-sport court, pull into either bay where there is room for three cars, a workshop, and storage. With half of the upper level finished, enjoy a generous studio to work in away from the main living areas or enter the stunning two-story barn with a walk-out to the rear lawn, ideal for summer soirees.
